Colas wins a 37-million euro contract in Hungary

Colas Hungaria, a Colas subsidiary in Hungary, has just been awarded a 37-million euro contract involving the widening of a section of the Budapest bypass Highway M0.

The contract, 85% of which is funded by the European Union funding, covers the widening of a 6.6 km section of highway to six lanes and the construction of access lanes and engineering structures.

Work is slated to begin in May 2009, with hand-over scheduled for June 2011.
