**Colas awarded a series of contracts in Canada
for a total of 140 million euros**

Benefiting from a buoyant market, Colas' Canadian companies have been awarded a series of big contracts, the four most important of which have a total contract value of 140 million euros.

- **In Alberta**, Standard General - Calgary just won a contract to build a rail intermodal site in Calgary for Canadian National railways (€1 M).
- **In Quebec**, Sintra won three new highway contracts:
 - Extension of Highway 410 for a 3.5-km section in Sherbrooke (€4 M)
 - Upgrading of Route 185 into Highway 85 for a 7-km section in the towns of Dégelis and Témiscouata-sur-le-Lac (€2 M)
 - Widening of a 7-km section of Highway 73 in Saint-Joseph-de-Beauce and Saints-Anges (€3 M)

The Colas Group is a leader in the construction and maintenance of infrastructure for transport, urban development and recreational facilities. With nearly 70,000 employees throughout more than 800 works centers and 1,400 materials production sites (aggregates, emulsion, bitumen, asphalt mix) in 40 countries on five continents, the Group carries out some 100,000 projects each year.

In 2010, Colas posted 11.7 billion euros of consolidated revenue (43% outside of France). The Group share of net profit amounted to 224 million euros.
