### **COLAS HAS REINFORCED ITS AGGREGATE BUSINESS IN WESTERN FRANCE**

On July 1, 2018, Colas Centre-Ouest has acquired Lafarge Holcim Granulats Ouest's Igneous Aggregates and Trading businesses located in western France.

The units consist of four production sites and two material trading platforms, employing a total of 46 people. They produce 1.5 million tons of aggregates each year for revenue of 17 million euros.

This acquisition is part of Colas' growth strategy in the production of building materials and strengthens its geographical coverage in western France.

Colas, a subsidiary of the Bouygues Group, is a world leader aiming to promote transport infrastructure solutions for sustainable mobility. With 55,000 employees in more than 50 countries on five continents, the Group performs some 80,000 road construction and maintenance projects each year via 800 construction business units and 2,000 material production units. In 2017, consolidated revenue at Colas totaled 11.7 billion euros (48% outside of France). Net profit attributable to the Group amounted to 328 million euros.
